Diana's life was transformed by her sewing machine

Diana is from Entebbe, Uganda, where she currently works as a tailor. She got pregnant as a teenager and her studies really suffered as a result. She eventually had to drop out of school and try to find money to feed her child.

Diana had minimal employment prospects, and every day was a struggle to make ends meet and put food on the table. One day, a friend told her about Mindset, our main partner in Uganda, who work with TWAM to provide training courses and tools to the most vulnerable members of society.

Diana saw an opportunity to transform her life and make sure her child could eat every day, so she joined the course.

After graduating from the course, she received a sewing machine and sewing kit, as do all the graduates thanks to TWAM's generous supporters. Diana now works six days a week making dresses, using a sewing machine which was adapted into a foot-operated treadle, as there is no electricity in the space that she rents. She makes seven dresses a week and is able to support her child.

"I gained skills and knowledge in tailoring. I have always dreamed of tailoring. I am what I am today because of my TWAM sewing machine."



Electrician's kit £25


